#### THE MERCIFUL CHRIST

### 1. JESUS AGAIN TELLS OF HIS DEATH AND RESURRECTION

A. LUKE 18: <sup>31</sup>JESUS TOOK THE TWELVE ASIDE AND TOLD THEM, "WE ARE GOING UP TO JERUSALEM, AND EVERYTHING THAT IS WRITTEN BY THE PROPHETS ABOUT THE SON OF MAN WILL BE FULFILLED. <sup>32</sup>HE WILL BE HANDED OVER TO THE GENTILES. THEY WILL MOCK HIM, INSULT HIM, SPIT ON HIM, FLOG HIM AND KILL HIM. <sup>33</sup>ON THE THIRD DAY HE WILL RISE AGAIN."

### 2. THE BLIND DISCIPLES

A. LUKE 18: <sup>34</sup>THE DISCIPLES DID NOT UNDERSTAND ANY OF THIS. ITS MEANING WAS HIDDEN FROM THEM, AND THEY DID NOT KNOW WHAT HE WAS TALKING ABOUT.

# 3. THE BLIND MAN BESIDE THE ROAD

A. Luke 18: <sup>35</sup>As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging. <sup>36</sup>When he heard the crowd going by, he asked what was happening. <sup>37</sup>They told him, "Jesus of Nazareth is passing by." <sup>38</sup>He called out, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" <sup>39</sup>Those who led the way rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" <sup>40</sup>Jesus stopped and ordered the man to be brought to him. When he came near, Jesus asked him, <sup>41</sup>"What do you want me to do for you?""Lord, I want to see," he replied. <sup>42</sup>Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has healed you." <sup>43</sup>Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus, praising God. When all the people saw it, they also praised God.

# 4. MERCY - GODS' DIVINE CHARACTER

- A. TO ALL CREATION
  - I. **PSALM 145:9** THE LORD IS GOOD TO ALL; HE HAS COMPASSION ON ALL HE HAS MADE.
  - II. ACTS 17:25 AND HE IS NOT SERVED BY HUMAN HANDS, AS IF HE NEEDED ANYTHING, BECAUSE HE HIMSELF GIVES ALL MEN LIFE AND BREATH AND EVERYTHING ELSE.
  - III. **PSALM 136:1** GIVE THANKS TO THE LORD, FOR HE IS GOOD.
    - (1) BUT EXERCISE OF HIS MERCY IS BASED ON HIS RIGHTEOUS WILL
      (A) PSALM 116:5 THE LORD IS GRACIOUS AND RIGHTEOUS; OUR GOD IS

- FULL OF COMPASSION.
- (B) ROMANS 9:15 FOR HE SAYS TO MOSES, "I WILL HAVE MERCY ON WHOM I HAVE MERCY, AND I WILL HAVE COMPASSION ON WHOM I HAVE COMPASSION."
- B. WILL NOT EXTEND TO THOSE WHO REJECT JESUS THE CHRIST
  - I. Luke 13:3 I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish.
  - II. ROMANS 3:8 WHY NOT SAY--AS WE ARE BEING SLANDEROUSLY REPORTED AS SAYING AND AS SOME CLAIM THAT WE SAY--"LET US DO EVIL THAT GOOD MAY RESULT"? THEIR CONDEMNATION IS DESERVED.
- C. BUT WHAT ABOUT THOSE WHO FOLLOW JESUS AS LORD AND SAVIOR
  - I. **PSALM 57:10** FOR GREAT IS YOUR LOVE, REACHING TO THE HEAVENS; YOUR FAITHFULNESS REACHES TO THE SKIES.
  - II. **PSALM 103:11** FOR AS HIGH AS THE HEAVENS ARE ABOVE THE EARTH, SO GREAT IS HIS LOVE FOR THOSE WHO FEAR HIM;
  - III. ROMANS 9:23 WHAT IF HE DID THIS TO MAKE THE RICHES OF HIS GLORY KNOWN TO THE OBJECTS OF HIS MERCY, WHOM HE PREPARED IN ADVANCE FOR GLORY—
  - IV. 2 COR. 1:3 PRAISE BE TO THE GOD AND FATHER OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, THE FATHER OF COMPASSION AND THE GOD OF ALL COMFORT,
  - V. **EPHESIANS. 2:4-5** BUT BECAUSE OF HIS GREAT LOVE FOR US, GOD, WHO IS RICH IN MERCY, <sup>5</sup>MADE US ALIVE WITH CHRIST EVEN WHEN WE WERE DEAD IN TRANSGRESSIONS--IT IS BY GRACE YOU HAVE BEEN SAVED.
  - VI. TITUS 3:5 HE SAVED US, NOT BECAUSE OF RIGHTEOUS THINGS WE HAD DONE, BUT BECAUSE OF HIS MERCY. HE SAVED US THROUGH THE WASHING OF REBIRTH AND RENEWAL BY THE HOLY SPIRIT,
  - VII. 1 PETER 1:3 PRAISE BE TO THE GOD AND FATHER OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST! IN HIS GREAT MERCY HE HAS GIVEN US NEW BIRTH INTO A LIVING HOPE THROUGH THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST FROM THE DEAD,

    His love endures forever.
