THE KINSMAN-REDEEMER LUKE 2:8

- 1. Luke 2:8-11 And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. ⁹An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. ¹⁰But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. ¹¹Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord.
 - a. The fields of Bethlehem
 - i. Creation
- 2. **Genesis 1:28** God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground." **God Had His Man**
 - a. Fall of man man had a new master, God Lost His Man the fields of Bethlehem was no longer a garden angry men came flood giants came
 - b. The fields were given to the Tribe of Judah
- 3. **Deuteronomy 25:5-10** If brothers are living together and one of them dies without a son, his widow must not marry outside the family. Her husband's brother shall take her and marry her and fulfill the duty of a brother-in-law to her. ⁶The first son she bears shall carry on the name of the dead brother so that his name will not be blotted out from Israel. ⁷However, if a man does not want to marry his brother's wife, take off one of his sandals, spit in his face and say, "This is what is done to the man who will not build up his brother's family line." ¹⁰That man's line shall be known in Israel as The Family of the Unsandaled.
- 4. Genesis 38:6-29 Judah got a wife for Er, his firstborn, and her name was Tamar
 - a. Then Judah said to Onan, "Lie with your brother's wife and fulfill your
 - b. my son Shelah grows up."
 - c. Judah's wife, the daughter of Shua, died.
 - d. "Your seal and its cord, and the staff in your hand," she answered. So he gave them to her and slept with her, and she became pregnant by him
 - e. Your daughter-in-law Tamar is guilty of prostitution, and as a result she is now pregnant."Judah said
 - f. , "Bring her out and have her burned to death!"
 - g. "I am pregnant by the man who owns these,"
 - h. "She is more righteous than I, since I wouldn't give her to my son Shelah."
 - i. And he was named Perez.
- 5. **Deuteronomy 23:2** No one born of a forbidden marriage nor any of his descendants may enter the assembly of the LORD, even down to the tenth generation.
- 6. Jeremiah 32:6-27 . Since it is your right to redeem it and possess it, buy it for yourself.'
 - a. 'Buy the field with silver and have the transaction witnessed.'
 - b. " ²⁶Then the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah: ²⁷"I am the LORD, the God of all mankind. Is anything too hard for me?
- 7. Israel takes the promise land, They fight the gaints for their properity
- 8. **Joshua 15:1** The allotment for the tribe of Judah, clan by clan, extended down to the territory of Edom, to the Desert of Zin in the extreme south.

- 9. **Joshua 15:12** The western boundary is the coastline of the Great Sea. These are the boundaries around the people of Judah by their clans.
- 10. Ruth 1:1-15 Fields was a man Elimelech, Naomi, two sons. Left the field and went to Moab
- 11. **Ruth 1:16-17** But Ruth replied, "Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God. ¹⁷Where you die I will die, and there I will be buried. May the LORD deal with me, be it ever so severely, if anything but death separates you and me."
- 12. Ruth goes to the fields to gather Food
- 13. Law of Gleaning .,
- 14. Ruth 2:5 Boaz asked the foreman of his harvesters, "Whose young woman is that?"
- 15. **Ruth 2:11-12** Boaz replied, "I've been told all about what you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband--how you left your father and mother and your homeland and came to live with a people you did not know before. ¹²May the LORD repay you for what you have done. May you be richly rewarded by the LORD, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to take refuge."
- 16. Ruth tells Naomi or Boaz kindness
- 17. Boaz had no problem with a Mobities, his mother was Rahab the harlot.
- 18. Naomi says he is a kinsman of mine.
- 19. Naomi tells Ruth what to do. Lay at the feet of Boaz as he sleeps.
- 20. **Ruth 3:9-10** "Who are you?" he asked."I am your servant Ruth," she said. "Spread the corner of your garment over me, since you are a kinsman-redeemer." ¹⁰"The LORD bless you, my daughter," he replied. "This kindness is greater than that which you showed earlier: You have not run after the younger men, whether rich or poor.
- 21. Boaz understands what she is asking, but there is a problem that he will confromt. There is a nearer kinsman-redeemer.
- 22. **Ruth 4:6-8** At this, the kinsman-redeemer said, "Then I cannot redeem it because I might endanger my own estate. You redeem it yourself. I cannot do it." ⁷(Now in earlier times in Israel, for the redemption and transfer of property to become final, one party took off his sandal and gave it to the other. This was the method of legalizing transactions in Israel.) ⁸So the kinsman-redeemer said to Boaz, "Buy it yourself." And he removed his sandal.
- 23. **Ruth 4:10** I have also acquired Ruth the Moabitess, Mahlon's widow, as my wife, in order to maintain the name of the dead with his property, so that his name will not disappear from among his family or from the town records. Today you are witnesses!"
- 24. **Ruth 4:16-22** Then Naomi took the child, laid him in her lap and cared for him. ¹⁷The women living there said, "Naomi has a son." And they named him Obed. He was the father of Jesse, the father of David. ¹⁸This, then, is the family line of Perez: Perez was the father of

- Hezron, ¹⁹Hezron the father of Ram, Ram the father of Amminadab, ²⁰Amminadab the father of Nahshon, Nahshon the father of Salmon, ²¹Salmon the father of Boaz, Boaz the father of Obed, ²²Obed the father of Jesse, and Jesse the father of David.
- 25. God was not ready for the people to have a King, the person He wanted was being taught in the FIELDS OF BETHLEHAM. His name was David.
- **26. But, God allowed a King -** I have looked upon my people, for their cry has reached me."

 ¹⁷When Samuel caught sight of Saul, the LORD said to him, "This is the man I spoke to you about; he will govern my people." -0
- 27. **Revelations 5:1-14** ⁹And they sang a new song: "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased [redeemed] men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation. ¹⁰You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth." ¹¹Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders. ¹²In a loud voice they sang: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!" ¹³Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!" ¹⁴The four living creatures said, "Amen," and the elders fell down and worshiped.
- 28. **Genesis 49:10** The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his.
- 29. **1 Cor. 6:19-20** Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; ²⁰you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.
- 30. Galatians 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
- 31. **Galatians 4:4-5** But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, ⁵to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons.
- 32. **Ephesians 1:7** In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace
- 33. Colossians 1:14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
- 34. **1 Timothy 2:5-6** For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, ⁶who gave himself as a ransom for all men--the testimony given in its proper time.
- 35. **Titus 2:14** who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good.
- 36. Hebrews 9:12 He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered

- the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.
- 37. **1 Peter 1:18-19** For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, ¹⁹but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.
- 38. **Revelations 5:9** And they sang a new song: "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.
