- **a.** Luke 22:1-2. Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread, called the Passover, was approaching, ² and the chief priests and the teachers of the law were looking for some way to get rid of Jesus, for they were afraid of the people.
- b. Luke 22:1-2. Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover. ²And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.

 - (I) EXODUS 12:21 THEN MOSES SUMMONED ALL THE ELDERS OF ISRAEL AND SAID TO THEM, "GO AT ONCE AND SELECT THE ANIMALS FOR YOUR FAMILIES AND SLAUGHTER THE PASSOVER LAMB.
 - III. WHAT IS HAPPENING HERE?
 - (1) WHO IS IN CHARGE?
 - (2) WHO IS THINKING THAT THEY ARE IN CHARGE?

2. JUDAS ISCARIOT

- a. ³Then satan-entered Judas, called Iscariot, one of the Twelve. ⁴And Judas went to the chief priests and the officers of the temple guard and discussed with them how he might betray Jesus. ⁵They were delighted and agreed to give him money. ⁶He consented, and watched for an opportunity to hand Jesus over to them when no crowd was present.
- b. Luke 22:3-6 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve. ⁴And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray him unto them. ⁵And they were glad, and covenanted to give him money. ⁶And he promised, and sought opportunity to betray him unto them in the absence of the multitude.
- c. TWO MAJOR PLAYERS
 - i. Satan
 - (1) **Ephesians 2:2** in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient.
 - (2) 1 Chronicles 21:1 Satan rose up against Israel and incited David to take a census of Israel.
 - (3) Job 1:6 One day the angels came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came with them.
 - (4) Acts 5:3 Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land?
 - (5) Acts 26:18 to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.'

(6) Romans 16:20 The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.

II. JUDAS ISCARIOT

- (1) JUDAS WAS A PREACHER AND HEALER OF MEN JUST LIKE THE OTHER APOSTLES.
 - (a) **Matthew** 10:1-20. And when he had called unto *him* his twelve disciples, he gave them power *against* unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease. ²Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James *the son* of Zebedee, and John his brother; ³Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James *the son* of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus; ⁴Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him. ⁵These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them,
 - (b) Mark 6:7-13. And he called *unto him* the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;
- (2) He had his name written in Heaven
 - (a) Psalm 69:25-28 May their place be deserted;do not let them share in your salvation. ²⁸May they be blotted out of the book of life and not be listed with the righteous.
 - (b) **Psalm 109:8-15** May his days be few; may another take his place of leadership ¹⁴May the iniquity of his fathers be remembered before the LORD; may the sin of his mother never be blotted out. ¹⁵May their sins always remain before the LORD, that he may cut off the memory of them from the earth.
 - (c) Acts 1:16-20 and said, "Brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled which the Holy Spirit spoke long ago through the mouth of David concerning Judas, who served as guide for those who arrested Jesus-- ¹⁷he was one of our number and shared in this ministry." ¹⁸(With the reward he got for his wickedness, Judas bought a field; there he fell headlong, his body burst open and all his intestines spilled out. ¹⁹Everyone in Jerusalem heard about this, so they called that field in their language Akeldama, that is, Field of Blood.) ²⁰"For," said Peter, "it is written in the book of Psalms, "'May his place be deserted;

 - (A) SATAN ENTERED INTO JUDAS
 - (I) SATAN A SPIRIT
 - 1) HAS A BODY
 - 2) JUDAS HAS A BODY
 - A) HOW DID THIS TAKE PLACE?
 - (B) When we say Christ in Me, Jesus in God, God in Jesus, what do we mean?
 - (i) Entered = eiserchomai, Greek 1525, Strong's eiserchomai, ice-er'-khom-ahee; from Greek 1519 (eis) and Greek 2064 (erchomai); to enter (literal or figurative) :- × arise, come (in, into), enter in (-to), go in (through).
 - 1) So this same word is used in scripture as LITERAL and FIGURATIVE.
 - a) Enter Literal When a demon enters a man
 - b) Figurative When we say, "Jesus is in us"
 - (ii) ONE IN PURPOSE.
 - 1) ALL TO THE SAME END, ONE IN MIND, PURPOSE, AND LIFE.
- III. SO NOW THE RELIGIOUS LEADERS, JUDAS, AND SATAN ALL WANT THE ARREST OF JESUS.
- IV. NOW THE MAJOR PROBLEM FOR JUDAS
 - (1) HE BETRAYED JESUS
 - (A) HE WANTED TO BETRAY JESUS!

- (2) HIS FALL WAS CAUSED BY TRANSGRESSION
 - (a) Acts 1:25. That he may take part of this ministry and apostleship, from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place.
 - (I) PARABAINO, GREEK 3845, STRONG'S PARABAINO, PAR-AB-AH'EE-NO; FROM GREEK 3844 (PARA) AND THE BASE OF GREEK 939 (BASIS); TO GO CONTRARY TO, I.E. VIOLATE A COMMAND: (BY) TRANSGRESS (-ION).
- V. ⁵AND THEY WERE GLAD, AND COVENANTED TO GIVE HIM MONEY.
 - (1) **SUNTITHEMAI, GREEK 4934, STRONG'S SUNTITHEMAI, SOON-TITH'-EM-AHEE**; MIDDLE FROM GREEK 4862 (SUN) AND GREEK 5087 (TITHEMI); TO *PLACE JOINTLY*, I.E. (FIGURATIVE) TO *CONSENT (BARGAIN, STIPULATE)*, *CONCUR*: AGREE, ASSENT, COVENANT.
 - (A) THEY MADE A COVENANT AND NOW THE PRIESTS, THE TEACHERS OF THE LAW, JUDAS AND SATAN ARE ALL ONE. ONE IN PURPOSE.

3. PREPARATION FOR THE PASSOVER

a. Luke 22:7-13 ⁷Then came the day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. ⁸Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, "GO AND MAKE PREPARATIONS FOR US TO EAT THE PASSOVER." ⁹"WHERE DO YOU WANT US TO PREPARE FOR IT?" THEY ASKED. ¹⁰HE REPLIED, "AS YOU ENTER THE CITY, A MAN CARRYING A JAR OF WATER WILL MEET YOU. FOLLOW HIM TO THE HOUSE THAT HE ENTERS, ¹¹AND SAY TO THE OWNER OF THE HOUSE, 'THE TEACHER ASKS: WHERE IS THE GUEST ROOM, WHERE I MAY EAT THE PASSOVER WITH MY DISCIPLES?' ¹²HE WILL SHOW YOU A LARGE UPPER ROOM, ALL FURNISHED. MAKE PREPARATIONS THERE." ¹³They left and found things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover.

THE BELIEVER' PASSOVER

Luke 22:14-20 ¹⁴When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. ¹⁵And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. ¹⁶For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God." ¹⁷After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. ¹⁸For I tell you I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." ¹⁹And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." ²⁰In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.
 - i. "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you
 - (1) JESUS NOW HAS SOMETHING TO GIVE THEM THAT THEY MUST HAVE.
 - ii. before I suffer

 - (III) THE SAVING OF ALL WHO ARE IN THE HOUSEHOLD.
- v. "Take this and divide it among you.
 - (1) Luke 22:17 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide *it* among yourselves:
 - (2) WHAT DID JESUS JUST DO? WHAT DID HE ASK THEM TO DO? WHAT IS THIS?
- VI. ¹⁹And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."
 - (1) BREAD
 - (A) gave thanks
 - (B) broke it.
 - (I) HE BROKE IT.
 - 1) WHY NOT THE APOSTLES?
 - A) BECAUSE IT IS PART OF THE NEW COVENANT, MADE BY GOD THE FATHER, THE SON AND THE HOLY SPIRIT. THEY BROKE THE BODY!
 - (C) gave it to them
 - (I) This is my body given for you
 - 1) 1 Peter 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.
 - (d) do this in remembrance of me."
 - (I) WHAT IS JESUS ASKING US TO DO?
 - 1) REMEMBER HIM
 - 2) Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
 - a) **Hebrews 13:8** Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

VII. WHAT DOES HE WANT THEM AND US TO KNOW?

(1) This cup is the **NEW COVENANT** in my blood, which is poured out for you.

Hebrews 10:1-9 For the law having a shadow of good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers there unto perfect. ²For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshipers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins. ³But in those *sacrifices there is* a remembrance again *made* of sins every year. ⁴For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. ⁵Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: ⁶In burnt offerings and *sacrifices* for sin thou hast had no pleasure. ⁷Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God. ⁸Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and *offering* for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure *therein;* which are offered by the law; ⁹Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He **taketh away the first,** that **he may establish the second**.

For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: ²⁴For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. ²⁵But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

FLESHLY SIGN OF OBEDIENCE

Romans 2:25 For circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision.

Romans 4:11 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also: 1 Corinthians 7:18 Is any man called being circumcised? let him not become uncircumcised. Is any called in uncircumcision? let him not be circumcised.

COULD NOT REDEEM

SENT TO REDEEM

Galatians 3:10-14 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them. ¹¹But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, *it is* evident: for, The just shall live by faith. ¹²And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them. ¹³Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangeth on a tree: ¹⁴That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. Ephesians 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; Colossians 1:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins: Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

2. THE BETRAYAL OF "THE SON OF MAN" FORETOLD

- a. Luke 22: ²¹⁻²³But the hand of him who is going to betray me is with mine on the table. ²²The Son of Man will go as it has been decreed, but woe to that man who betrays him." ²³They began to question among themselves which of them it might be who would do this.
 - I. BETRAY ME IS WITH MINE ON THE TABLE
 - (1) HERE IN THESE PASSAGES JESUS WILL SHOW THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE BETRAYER AND SIMON.
 - II. 22THE SON OF MAN WILL GO AS IT HAS BEEN DECREED
 - (1) YES IT IS TRUE THAT ALL THIS WILL HAVE TO COME TO PASS.
 - III. BUT WOE TO THAT MAN WHO BETRAYS HIM
 - (1) WE MUST BE VERY CAREFUL OF THE WAY WE LIVE OUR LIVES.
 - IV. ²³THEY BEGAN TO QUESTION AMONG THEMSELVES WHICH OF THEM IT MIGHT BE WHO WOULD DO THIS.
 - (1) THEY BEGAN TO QUESTION AMONG THEMSELVES WHICH OF THEM
 - (A) I WOULD HAVE THOUGHT THAT THEY WOULD HAVE BEEN SAYING NONE OF US!
 - (2) THEY ARE SAYING THAT IT IS POSSIBLE ONE THAT HAS WALKED WITH JESUS FOR THREE YEARS COULD BE THE ONE, AND NOT A ONE OF THEM STOOD OUT ABOVE THE REST!!!!

3. FROM BETRAYER TO GREATNESS!

- a. Luke 22:²⁴⁻²⁷Also a dispute arose among them as to which of them was considered to be greatest. ²⁵Jesus said to them, "The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them; and those who exercise authority over them call themselves Benefactors. ²⁶But you are not to be like that. Instead, the greatest among you should be like the youngest, and the one who rules like the one who serves. ²⁷For who is greater, the one who is at the table or the one who serves? Is it not the one who is at the table? But I am among you as one who serves.
 - i. Jesus had just said that one of you would betray me.
 - (1) Notice how worried they really were about this!
 - ii. which of them was considered to be greatest.
 - (1) What were they wanting?
 - iii. JESUS GIVES US A LOOK INTO THE KINGDOM OF GOD

FAILURE IN THESE AREAS CAUSED THE FALL OF LUCIFER

Isaiah 14:12-14 How you have fallen from heaven, O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations! ¹³You said in your heart,"I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of the sacred mountain. ¹⁴I will ascend above the tops of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High."

4. WHAT IS AHEAD FOR THE APOSTLES

- a. Luke 22: ²⁸⁻³⁰You are those who have stood by me in my trials. ²⁹And I confer on you a kingdom, just as my Father conferred one on me, ³⁰so that you may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom and sit on thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
 - I. 28-30 YOU ARE THOSE WHO HAVE STOOD BY ME IN MY TRIALS
 - (1) WHAT IS IMPORTANT TO JESUS?

- II. ²⁹AND I CONFER ON YOU A KINGDOM,
 - (1) JUST AS MY FATHER CONFERRED ONE ON ME
 - (a) **Daniel 7:18** But the saints of the Most High will receive the kingdom and will possess it forever--yes, for ever and ever.'
 - (b) **Daniel 7:27** Then the sovereignty, power and greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven will be handed over to the saints, the people of the Most High. His kingdom will be an everlasting kingdom, and all rulers will worship and obey him.'
 - (c) Romans 8:17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs--heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.
 - (d) 1 Corinthians 4:8 Already you have all you want! Already you have become rich! You have become kings--and that without us! How I wish that you really had become kings so that we might be kings with you!
 - (e) 1 Corinthians 6:2-3 Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if you are to judge the world, are you not competent to judge trivial cases? ³Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more the things of this life!
 - (f) 2 Timothy 2:12 if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us;
 - (g) **Revelations 5:10** You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth."
 - (h) Revelations 20:4-6 I saw thrones on which were seated those who had been given authority to judge. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony for Jesus and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or his image and had not received his mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years. ⁵(The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended.) This is the first resurrection. ⁶Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years.
- III. JUST WHAT WILL THE APOSTLES BE DOING?

 - (A) ⁵⁸A LITTLE LATER SOMEONE ELSE SAW HIM AND SAID, "YOU ALSO ARE ONE OF THEM."
 - (I) THE FIRST CHARGE. "YOU WERE WITH HIM"

 - 1) YOU WERE NOT JUST WITH HIM, YOU ARE ONE OF THEM.
 - A) YOU ARE ONE OF THOSE CHRISTIANS.

- (7) PETER WHO SAID HE WOULD GIVE HIS LIVE FOR THE LORD NOW HAS A SECOND CHANCE TO STAND WITH HIM.
 - (A) "MAN, I AM NOT!" PETER REPLIED
 - (B) WHAT DOES PETER SAY ABOUT IDENTIFYING WITH THE LORD LATER?
 - (I) 1 Peter 1:6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials.
 - (ii) 1 Peter 2:20 But how is it to your credit if you receive a beating for doing wrong and endure it? But if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God.
 - (iii) 1 Peter 3:14 But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed. "Do not fear what they fear; do not be frightened."
 - (iv) 1 Peter 3:17 It is better, if it is God's will, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil.
