
DANIEL THE RISE AND FALL OF KINGDOMS NEBUCHADNEZZAR DREAMS

1. THE KING CALLS ON THE CHALDEANS

- **a.** Daniel 2:1-3 (KJV) And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him. ²Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to shew the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king. ³And the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my spirit was troubled to know the dream.
 - I. TWO = WITNESS
 - (1) THIS PORTION OF SCRIPTURE WILL DEAL WITH A WITNESS. SOME THING WILL BECOME KNOWN.
 - II. EVEN THOUGH
 NEBUCHADNEZZAR IS THE
 MOST POWERFUL MAN IN THE
 AREA HE IS STILL TROUBLED.
 - III. THE KING HAD SPENT A LOT OF MONEY IN TRAINING PEOPLE TO HELP HIM IN TIMES LIKE THIS.



2. THE KINGS' DEMAND

- a. Daniel 2:⁴⁻⁹Then spake the Chaldeans to the king in Syriack, O king, live for ever: tell thy servants the dream, and we will shew the interpretation. ⁵The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, The thing is gone from me: if ye will not make known unto me the dream, with the interpretation thereof, ye shall be cut in pieces, and your houses shall be made a dunghill. ⁶But if ye shew the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honor: therefore shew me the dream, and the interpretation thereof. ⁷They answered again and said, Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will shew the interpretation of it. ⁸The king answered and said, I know of certainty that ye would gain the time, because ye see the thing is gone from me. ⁹But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, *there is but* one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can shew me the interpretation thereof
 - I. .'ARAMIYTH, HEBREW 762, STRONG'S 'ARAMIYTH, AR-AW-MEETH'; FEMININE OF HEBREW 761 ('ARAMMIY); (ONLY ADVERBIAL) IN ARAMÆAN: IN THE SYRIAN LANGUAGE (TONGUE), IN SYRIACK.
 - II. TELL THY SERVANTS THE DREAM, AND WE WILL SHEW THE INTERPRETATION.
 - (1) YOU TELL ME WHAT YOU DREAMED AND GOD WILL TELL ME WHAT IT MEANS. (A) SOUNDS LIKE TODAY.
 - (2) BUT THEY HAVE A PROBLEM.

- (A) THE KING CAN NOT RECALL THE DREAM. HE JUST KNOWS THAT HE IS TROUBLED BY WHAT HE IS DREAMING ABOUT IN HIS DREAMS.
- III. THE KING IS LOOKING FOR TWO THINGS.
 - (1) TWO A WITNESS TO THERE ABILITY TO DO THIS THING.
 - (2) TELL ME THE DREAM
 - (3) & THEN TELL ME WHAT IT MEANS.
- IV. IF YOU CAN NOT DO THIS!
 - (1) YE SHALL BE CUT IN PIECES, AND YOUR HOUSES SHALL BE MADE A DUNGHILL.
- V. BUT IF YOU CAN.
 - (1) ⁶But if ye shew the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honor: therefore shew me the dream, and the interpretation thereof.
- VI. AGAIN, THE SECOND TIME THESE WORDS ARE SPOKEN
 - (1) ⁷THEY ANSWERED AGAIN AND SAID, LET THE KING TELL HIS SERVANTS THE DREAM, AND WE WILL SHEW THE INTERPRETATION OF IT.
- VII. AND AGAIN, THE KING SPEAKS.
 - (1) I KNOW OF CERTAINTY THAT YE WOULD GAIN THE TIME
 - (2) BECAUSE YE SEE THE THING IS GONE FROM ME.
 - (3) ⁹BUT IF YE WILL NOT MAKE KNOWN UNTO ME THE DREAM,
 - (A) THERE IS BUT ONE DECREE FOR YOU
 - (B) FOR YE HAVE PREPARED LYING AND CORRUPT WORDS TO SPEAK BEFORE ME
 - (4) TILL THE TIME BE CHANGED:
 - (A) I AM GOING TO GIVE YOU SOME TIME TO DO THIS IN.
 - (5) THEREFORE TELL ME THE DREAM, AND I SHALL KNOW THAT YE CAN SHEW ME THE INTERPRETATION THEREOF
 - (A) HE WANTS AN ANSWER TO HIS DREAM PROBLEM. HE IS NOT WANTING TO KILL HIS ADVISORS.
 - (I) HE WANTS AN ANSWER.

3. THE TRUTH ABOUT THE WISE MEN

- a. Daniel 2:¹⁰⁻¹¹The Chaldeans answered before the king, and said, There is not a man upon the earth that can shew the king's matter: therefore *there is* no king, lord, nor ruler, *that* asked such things at any magician, or astrologer, or Chaldean. ¹¹And *it is* a rare thing that the king requireth, and there is none other that can shew it before the king, except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh
 - I. HEAR! HEAR THE WORDS OF THE WISE MEN.
 - (1) THERE IS NOT A MAN UPON THE EARTH THAT CAN SHEW THE KING'S MATTER:
 - (A) WHAT YOU ASK US, WE CAN NOT DO. BUT NO ONE ELSE CAN EITHER.
 - (2) THEREFORE *THERE IS* NO KING, LORD, NOR RULER, *THAT* ASKED SUCH THINGS AT ANY MAGICIAN, OR ASTROLOGER, OR CHALDEAN
 - (3) ¹¹AND *IT IS* A RARE THING THAT THE KING REQUIRETH,
 - (4) AND THERE IS NONE OTHER THAT CAN SHEW IT BEFORE THE KING, EXCEPT THE GODS, EXCEPT THE GODS, WHOSE DWELLING IS NOT WITH FLESH
 - (A) HERE IS THE WITNESS.

- (I) NO MAN CAN KNOW THE ANSWER, ONLY GOD.
- (II) THE PROBLEM WITH THAT, GOD DOES NOT DWELL WITH MAN.

4. THE KING VOICES HIS FEELINGS

- a. Daniel 2:¹²For this cause the king was angry and very furious, and commanded to destroy all the wise *men* of Babylon. ¹³And the decree went forth that the wise *men* should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain.
 - I. THE KING IS DISAPPOINTED IN HIS FOLLOWERS.
 - (1) THEY COULD NOT DO WHAT HE HAD THEM TRAINED TO DO.
 - (2) HOW MANY TIMES HAD HE SOUGHT THERE ADVISE AND FOLLOWED IT?
 - II. THEY SOUGHT DANIEL AND HIS FOLLOWERS.
 - (1) HE BEING NEW WAS NOT CALLED INTO THE PRESENCE OF THE KING.
 - (A) HOW OFTEN DO WE SEEK COUNSEL FROM THE WRONG PERSON OR PERSONS.
 - (B) HERE THEY WERE GOING TO KILL DANIEL BECAUSE OF WHAT OTHERS COULD NOT DO.

5. DANIEL AGREES WITH THE WISE MEN-HE ACTS.

- a. Daniel 2:¹⁴⁻¹⁸Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise *men* of Babylon: ¹⁵He answered and said to Arioch [*ar-yoke']*; the king's captain, Why *is* the decree *so* hasty from the king? Then Arioch made the thing known to Daniel. ¹⁶Then Daniel went in, and desired of the king that he would give him time, and that he would shew the king the interpretation. ¹⁷Then Daniel went to his house, and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions: ¹⁸That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise *men* of Babylon.
 - I. DANIEL, A MAN WHO LIVED BEFORE GOD.
 - II. WHEN HE IS FACED WITH A GRAVE SITUATION.
 - (1) WHAT DID HE DO?
 - (A) HE ANSWERED WITH COUNSEL AND WISDOM
 - (I) **`ETA', HEBREW 5843, STRONG'S `ETA',** *AY-TAW'*; (CHALDEE); FROM HEBREW 3272 (Y^E`AT); *PRUDENCE* :- COUNSEL.
 - (II) TA`AM, HEBREW 2941, STRONG'S TA`AM, TAH'-AM; (CHALDEE); FROM HEBREW 2939 (TE`AM); PROPERLY A TASTE, I.E. (AS IN HEBREW 2940 (TA`AM)) A JUDICIAL SENTENCE: ACCOUNT, × TO BE COMMANDED, COMMANDMENT, MATTER.
 - III. WHAT IS THIS MAN TO DO?
 - IV. WHAT DOES DANIEL ASK OF HIM
 - (1) WHAT WAS DANIEL GETTING AT?
 - V. WHAT DID HE WANT?
 - VI. ARE YOU SUPRISED AT THE ASSURANCE OF DANIEL?
 - (1) AND DESIRED OF THE KING THAT HE WOULD GIVE HIM TIME,
 - (2) AND THAT HE WOULD SHEW THE KING THE INTERPRETATION
 - VII. WE KNOW THAT HE FOUND FAVOR WITH THE KING BECAUSE HE WAS NOT PUT TO

DEATH.

VIII. NOW WHAT DOES HE DO?

- (1) ¹⁷THEN DANIEL WENT TO HIS HOUSE
- (2) AND MADE THE THING KNOWN TO HANANIAH, MISHAEL, AND AZARIAH, HIS COMPANIONS:
- (3) THEY WOULD DESIRE MERCIES OF THE GOD OF HEAVEN CONCERNING THIS SECRET;
- (4) DANIEL AND HIS FELLOWS SHOULD NOT PERISH WITH THE REST OF THE WISE MEN OF BABYLON.
 - (A) How big was the request of God?

6. GOD GIVES THE ANSWER!

- a. Daniel 2:¹⁹⁻²³Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven. ²⁰Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his: ²¹And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding: ²²He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what *is* in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him. ²³I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast *now* made known unto us the king's matter
 - I. WHEN THESE YOUNG MEN NEEDED WISDOM, WHAT WAS GODS' RESPONSE?
 - (1) 2:19-23 Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision

II. WISDOM

- (1) HOW MUCH SUPERIOR IS WISDOM TO FOLLY?
 - (a) Eccles. 2:13-14 (KJV) Then I saw that wisdom excelleth folly, as far as light excelleth darkness. ¹⁴The wise man's eyes *are* in his head; but the fool walketh in darkness: and I myself perceived also that one event happeneth to them all.
- (2) What should be the desire of all people?
 - (a) Psalm 90:12 (KJV) So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom.
- (3) How do we describe wisdom
 - (a) **Proverbs 9:10 (KJV)** The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy *is* understanding.
- (4) How may it be obtained?
 - (a) Eccles. 2:26 (KJV) For *God* giveth to a man that *is* good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to *him that is* good before God. This also *is* vanity and vexation of spirit.
- (5) WHAT IS THE ADVANTAGE OF GAINING?
 - (a) **Proverbs 16:16 (KJV)** How much better *is it* to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!
- (6) HAVE WE ANY MARKS OF THE WISDOM OF GOD?
 - (a) **Proverbs 3:19 (KJV)** The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens.
- (7) WHAT IS THE GOSPEL SOME TIMES CALLED?
 - (a) 1 Cor. 2:7 (KJV) But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, *even* the hidden *wisdom*, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

- (8) WHAT IS SAID OF THE WISDOM OF SOLOMON?
 - (a) 1 Kings 4:29-30 (KJV) And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that *is* on the sea shore. ³⁰And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.
- III. HOW DOES DANIEL SEE GOD?
 - (1) Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever:
 - (a) **barak**, *baw-rak'*; a primitive root; to *kneel*; by implication to *bless* God (as an act of adoration), and (vice-versa) man (as a benefit); also (by euphemism) to *curse* (God or the king, as treason):- × abundantly, × altogether, × at all, blaspheme, bless, congratulate, curse, × greatly, × indeed, kneel (down), praise, salute, × still, thank.
 - (2) FOR WISDOM AND MIGHT ARE HIS:
 - (3) ²¹AND HE CHANGETH THE TIMES
 - (4) AND THE SEASONS
 - (5) HE REMOVETH KINGS,
 - (6) AND SETTETH UP KINGS
 - (7) HE GIVETH WISDOM UNTO THE WISE
 - (A) CHAKAM, *KHAW-KAM'*; A PRIMITIVE ROOT, TO *BE WISE* (IN MIND, WORD OR ACT) :- × EXCEEDING, TEACH WISDOM, BE (MAKE SELF, SHEW SELF) WISE, DEAL (NEVER SO) WISELY, MAKE WISER.
 - (8) KNOWLEDGE TO THEM THAT KNOW UNDERSTANDING:
 - (9) ²²HE REVEALETH THE DEEP
 - (10) ²²HE REVEALETH SECRET THINGS
 - (11) HE KNOWETH WHAT IS IN THE DARKNESS,
 - (12) THE LIGHT DWELLETH WITH HIM
- IV. WHAT IS DANIELS' ATTITUDE TOWARDS GOD?
 - (1) ^{23}I THANK THEE,
 - (2) AND PRAISE THEE,
 - (A) O THOU GOD OF MY FATHERS,
- V. WHAT HAS GOD DONE FOR DANIEL?
 - (1) WHO HAST GIVEN ME WISDOM AND MIGHT,
 - (2) AND HAST MADE KNOWN UNTO ME NOW
 - (3) WHAT WE DESIRED OF THEE:
 - (4) FOR THOU HAST NOW MADE KNOWN UNTO US THE KING'S MATTER
 - (A) LOOK AT THE SEASON AND TIMING OF THIS!
- 7. Daniel ready for the King!
 - a. Daniel 2:²⁴⁻²⁶Therefore Daniel went in unto Arioch, whom the king had ordained to destroy the wise *men* of Babylon: he went and said thus unto him; Destroy not the wise *men* of Babylon: bring me in before the king, and I will shew unto the king the interpretation. ²⁵Then Arioch brought in Daniel before the king in haste and said thus unto him, I have found a man of the captives of Judah, that will make known unto the king the interpretation. ²⁶The king answered and said to Daniel, whose name *was* Belteshazzar, Art thou able to make known unto me the dream which I have seen, and the

interpretation thereof?

 - ii. and the interpretation thereof?
- 8. DANIEL MAKES IT CLEAR THAT THE KING IS LOOKING FOR ANSWERS IN THE WRONG PLACE
 - a. Daniel2:²⁷-30Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded cannot the wise *men*, the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, shew unto the king; ²⁸But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days. Thy dream, and the visions of thy head upon thy bed, are these; ²⁹As for thee, O king, thy thoughts came *into thy mind* upon thy bed, what should come to pass hereafter: and he that revealeth secrets maketh known to thee what shall come to pass. ³⁰But as for me, this secret is not revealed to me for *any* wisdom that I have more than any living, but for *their* sakes that shall make known the interpretation to the king, and that thou mightest know the thoughts of thy heart
 - I. WHAT DANIEL WANTS THE KING TO KNOW.
 - (1) THE SECRET WHICH THE KING HATH DEMANDED CANNOT THE WISE *MEN*, THE ASTROLOGERS, THE MAGICIANS, THE SOOTHSAYERS, SHEW UNTO THE KING;
 - (2) ²⁸But there is a God in Heaven that revealeth secrets
 - (3), AND MAKETH KNOWN TO THE KING NEBUCHADNEZZAR WHAT SHALL BE IN THE LATTER DAYS.
 - II. WHAT DANIEL WANTS THE KING TO KNOW ABOUT THE KING.
 - (1) THY DREAM, AND THE VISIONS OF THY HEAD UPON THY BED, ARE THESE;
 - (A) ²⁹AS FOR THEE, O KING, THY THOUGHTS CAME *INTO THY MIND* UPON THY BED,
 - (B) WHAT SHOULD COME TO PASS HEREAFTER:
 - (C) AND HE THAT REVEALETH SECRETS MAKETH KNOWN TO THEE WHAT SHALL COME TO PASS.
 - (2) WHAT DANIEL HAS TO TELL THE KING ABOUT DANIEL!
 - (A) ³⁰BUT AS FOR ME, THIS SECRET IS NOT REVEALED TO ME FOR *ANY* WISDOM THAT I HAVE MORE THAN ANY LIVING, BUT FOR *THEIR* SAKES THAT SHALL MAKE

- KNOWN THE INTERPRETATION TO THE KING, AND THAT THOU MIGHTEST KNOW THE THOUGHTS OF THY HEART
- (B) .DANIEL 2:30 (NIV) AS FOR ME, THIS MYSTERY HAS BEEN REVEALED TO ME, NOT BECAUSE I HAVE GREATER WISDOM THAN OTHER LIVING MEN, BUT SO THAT YOU, O KING, MAY KNOW THE INTERPRETATION AND THAT YOU MAY UNDERSTAND WHAT WENT THROUGH YOUR MIND.
 - (I) THIS MYSTERY HAS BEEN REVEALED TO ME
 - 1) , NOT BECAUSE I HAVE GREATER WISDOM THAN OTHER LIVING MEN,
 - (II) BUT SO THAT YOU, O KING, MAY KNOW THE INTERPRETATION
 - (III) AND THAT YOU MAY UNDERSTAND WHAT WENT THROUGH YOUR MIND.

9. THE GREAT IMAGE - FIVE PARTS

- a. Daniel 2:³¹⁻³⁵ Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof *was* terrible. ³²This image's head *was* of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass, ³³His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay. ³⁴Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet *that were* of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces. ³⁵Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.
 - I. THE IMAGE
 - (1) THIS GREAT IMAGE,
 - (2) WHOSE BRIGHTNESS WAS EXCELLENT,
 - (3) STOOD BEFORE THEE; AND
 - (4) THE FORM THEREOF *WAS* TERRIBLE
 - II. PARTS OF THE IMAGE
 - (1) ³²THIS IMAGE'S HEAD *WAS* OF FINE GOLD,
 - (2) HIS BREAST AND HIS ARMS OF SILVER,
 - (3) HIS BELLY AND HIS THIGHS OF BRASS,
 - (4) ³³HIS LEGS OF IRON,
 - (5) HIS FEET PART OF IRON AND PART OF CLAY.
 - III. AS THIS IMAGE STOOD BEFORE YOU SOMETHING HAPPENED!
 - (1) ³⁴THOU SAWEST TILL THAT A STONE WAS CUT OUT WITHOUT HANDS,
 - (2) WHICH SMOTE THE IMAGE UPON HIS FEET THAT WERE OF IRON AND CLAY,
 - (3) AND BRAKE THEM TO PIECES.
 - (4) ³⁵Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors;
 - (5) AND THE WIND CARRIED THEM AWAY, THAT NO PLACE WAS FOUND FOR THEM:
 - (6) AND THE STONE THAT SMOTE THE IMAGE BECAME A GREAT MOUNTAIN,
 - (7) AND FILLED THE WHOLE EARTH

THE INTERPRETATION


- 1. HEAD OF GOLD WORLD EMPIRE
 - a. Daniel 2:³⁶⁻³⁸This is the dream; and we will tell the interpretation thereof before the king. ³⁷Thou, O king, art a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory. ³⁸And wheresoever the children of men dwell, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the heaven hath he given into thine hand, and hath made thee ruler over them all. Thou art this head of gold.
 - i. Now as we hear this, we must remember that God is the maker of kings and kingdoms. He through Daniel is giving us in sight into Kingdoms.

 - (7) NEO-BABYLONIAN EMPIRE [605-539B.C.]
 - II. LOOK CLOSE WHAT DOES THIS SAY ABOUT THE NEO-BABYLONIAN EMPIRE?

2. Breast and Arms of Silver -

- a. Daniel 2: ^{39-a} And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee,
 - i. Kingdom inferior to thee -
 - (1) This kingdom will be the Medo-Persian empire established by Cyrus
 - (A) THE MEDO-PERSIAN EMPIRE INCLUDED ALL LANDS OF MEDIA AND PERSIA, MUCH OF THE AREA SHOWN ON THIS MAP AND MORE. THE JEWISH EXILES WERE CONCENTRATED IN THE AREA AROUND NIPPUR IN THE

BABYLONIAN



PROVINCE. THE DECREE BY KING CYRUS THAT ALLOWED THE ISRAELITES TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMELAND AND REBUILD THE TEMPLE WAS DISCOVERED IN THE PALACE AT ECBATANA. §

3. THE GREEK EMPIRE - BRASS KINGDOM

- a. and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.
 - I. THIS IS THE EMPIRE ESTABLISHED BY ALEXANDER THE GREAT
 - II. 330 BC
